AI Sired Females

These are home raised heifers, and out of our AI program.

Daughters of; Redemption, New Direction, K2 Max and Hamilton.

Moderate frame and easy keeping heifers that should make top females in any operation.

AI bred May 17-19, and bull bred May 22-June 10. They were ultrasound pregnancy checked and are tagged according to due date with green and white tags.

AI bred to K2 Max and bull bred to our 2 Resilience sons K2 Reese 687 & K2 Resilient 637

Max & Redemption daughters were AI bred to K2 Reacher; a top seller in 2016 as a high elevation, calving ease sire from a great cow family.

Bull Bred Heifers

23 Head—yellow tags

Bred June 10-July 25

There are a lot of our home raised heifers in this group that were from our summer program.

This is potentially a good set of heifers for high elevations. Our home raised heifers were out of low PAP bulls, and the source for these younger purchased heifers is a cow herd that has ran 7000-8000 feet for many years.

Bred May 17-19

These heifers are AI bred in our first AI breeding group. They were bred over 3 days, and are due to calve February 20th.

These heifers were bred in a 20 day breeding time, and should be due to calve about March 1-19.

Bred June 5-7

This group was bred in our 2nd AI breeding. These heifers were sorted for age and type prior to the start of the breeding season. (they are not heifers that failed to cycle for the May breeding group!)

AI Bred June 5-7

Bull Bred June 10-July 25

For those who love the Red White Face cattle and the hybrid vigor they provide, this is a wonderful set of heifers that will be great range cows.

Ultrasound Pregnancy dated and tagged with breeding date tags.

Another good set of heifers with potential for high elevations. Same heifers as lot 30–31, just sorted for color.
