Lot 9 is out of a true breed legend in maternal quality, and in my opinion she should be flushed herself. Her sire, Galena 60 was born in 1970, and died in the tragic fire at the ABS bull stud in the 1980's. He is a bull I researched, and then searched for. When I found 1 straw we used it in a flush where we got several bulls, and 1 female. One of the bulls we got to see as a 10 year old, and he still not only looked great, but had excellent food and leg structure. In a time where foot structure and maternal excellence are sought after, these are the foundation bloodlines to bring those traits back! The lot 9 cow has excellent udder structure for a cow of any age, even as a 10 year old.


